K-20 Product Information, Pricing, and Ordering Instructions

NoodleBib is a fully-integrated note-taking and documentation program which is anchored in the best practices of academic research and inquiry learning. Known as the most comprehensive and accurate MLA- and APA-style bibliography composer on the Web, NoodleBib includes a note-taking component which enables students to extract, organize and synthesize information that they find during the research process. NoodleBib is a flexible teaching tool which supports both individual learning preferences and a variety of teaching styles.

Over 6,000 subscribing K-12 schools, community colleges, and universities have discovered the benefits of NoodleBib:

- A **learning and teaching tool**, not simply a "machine" that automates the process.
- **Extensive help** for each citation element at the point of need, a growing knowledge base of examples and fast, personal responses to individual student/teacher citation questions.

NJRLC member schools receive a **20% discount** off of standard academic pricing. Standard academic pricing for individual schools is available on the Web at:

Most single-campus license subscribers will fit into one of the following ranges:

Single-campus enrollment	Standard academic cost	NJRLC member cost (20% discount)
<= 250	\$120.00	\$96.00
251 – 1000	\$240.00	\$192.00
1001 – 4000	\$360.00	\$288.00
4001 - 5000	\$420.00	\$336.00
5001 – 6000	\$480.00	\$384.00
6001 - 7000	\$540.00	\$432.00
7001 - 8000	\$600.00	\$480.00

For full-district licenses (all middle and high schools in the district participating), the 20% discount is applied on top of the variable full-district license discount of 10-40% described on the Web site:

Example calculations:

1. One high school with enrollment of 4,500.

$$\text{Cost} = \$420.00 * 0.80 = \$336.00/\text{yr}$$

Note: 0.80 is the 20% NJRLC member discount.

2. One elementary school with enrollment of 200.

$$\text{Cost} = \$120.00 * 0.80 = \$96.00/\text{yr}$$

Note: 0.80 is the 20% NJRLC member discount.

3. District with 5 high schools (each with enrollment of 2,000), 5 middle schools (each with enrollment of 800), and 12 elementary schools.

$$\text{Cost} = ((\$360.00 * 5) + (\$240.00 * 5)) * 0.70 * 0.80 = \$1,680.00/\text{yr}$$

Note: 0.70 is the 30% district-wide license discount (for a district with 8-15 middle and high schools). 0.80 is the 20% NJRLC member discount. Elementary schools are included free with the district-wide license.
